## **Information regarding the processing of personal data in the Polish Foundrymen's Association**

In connection with the implementation of the requirements of the European Parliament and of the Council (EU) dated 2016/679 of 27<sup>th</sup> April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and the repeal of Directive 95/46 / EC (general data protection regulation "RODO"), we inform about the rules of personal data processing and about your rights related to this.

The following rules apply from May 25<sup>th</sup>, 2018.

1. The administrator of the personal data is the Polish Foundrymen's Association, ul. Zakopiańska 73, 30-418 Kraków, NIP 676-007-87-03.
2. If there are any questions about the manner and scope of processing of personal data, as well as your rights, you can contact Ms. Katarzyna Liszka by phone, on + 48 12 352 39 60 and by e-mail, address [zg@stowarzyszenie-stop.pl](mailto:zg@stowarzyszenie-stop.pl).
3. The personal data administrator processes your personal data on the basis of applicable laws, concluded agreements and on the basis of granted consent.
4. Your personal data are processed in order to implement the concluded contracts.
5. In connection with the processing of data for the purposes referred to in point 4, the recipients of your personal data may be other entities which, based on relevant agreements signed with the Administrator, process personal data for the Administrator.
6. Your personal data will be kept for the period necessary to achieve the objectives set out in point 4, and after that for the period and to the extent required by the provisions of generally applicable law.
7. In relation to the processing of your personal data, you have the following rights:
  - a) the right to access personal data, including the right to obtain a copy of this data,
  - b) the right to request correction of personal data - if the data is incorrect or incomplete,
  - c) the right to request the deletion of personal data (the so-called right to be forgotten).
8. If the processing of personal data takes place on the basis of the person's consent to the processing of personal data (Article 6 (1) letter and RODO), you have the right to withdraw your consent at any time. The withdrawal does not affect the compliance of the processing, which was made on the basis of the consent prior to its withdrawal, according to the applicable law.
9. If you are informed of unlawful processing of your personal data in the Association, you have the right to issue a complaint with the supervisory authority competent in matters of personal data protection.
10. In the situation where the processing of personal data is based on the consent of the person, the provision of personal data by you is voluntary.
11. Your data can be processed in an automated manner and will not be profiled.
